Secretary Notes:

The march Executive meeting was held at my place with eleven members present. As usual every thing from chicken rearing to child birth was discussed.

The Lodge, its upkeep and usage was considered in depth. As our main capital asset it deserves to to be maintained to a good standard, and the money invested in the improvements over recent years is considered by the Executive to be well spent. However although it is well patronised it is not a "cash cow" for the club and the moneys for recent upgrades has had to come from the Clubs savings. At \$80 for four persons and \$20 for each extra adult to hire the facility, this sum is generally considered ridiculously cheap and the Executive considers that raising the fee to \$100 for four persons and \$25 for each extra is still very good value and will assist in covering the cost of improvements. The next requirement for the Lodge is to redecorate the inside and that will be the main undertaking at the next working bee. While on the subject of the Lodge, the firewood supply has been seriously depleted and has been replenished recently at the Clubs expense. One of the conditions of hire is that where possible people bring their own firewood or at least a contribution, so if hiring the Lodge throw in a bag of wood thanks.

On further financial matters, Henry said we are not holding our own with the present subscription set at \$50. Running events such as the Christmas BBQ, and the Marathon will never break even and are topped up from reserves. These events benefit many of the members and don't necessarily have to run at a profit, but it is not prudent to be chipping away at the bank account to the position of having to draw on the savings. Many people question why the Boat Club needs so much in reserves but it is due to the Lodge not being covered now in the event of it being flooded. It is covered for fire etc but not that jolly lake, so we need that nest egg to cover the possibility of having to refurbish after that event. What this means then, is that the Treasurer will recommend at the AGM, that subscriptions be raised to \$60 per year. Still good value and a lot less than some of our kindred clubs.

RED SETTER MAKES IT TO KINGSTON KATCH

Insite of predictions through the week for strong winds on Wakatipu for the weekend, we decided we should support the event.

Cook had us up early on Saturday morning and we were on the road by seven arriving to find the lake quite boat able. There were boats still parked up at the Lodge when we went past and we were launched before most of them got to the ramp.

I had a plan to fish up the west side of the lake so that if the strong winds did arrive it would be safer to scurry for home with the waves square onto the stern. That wasn't necessary and although the lake got a bit lumpy it was no worse than other times . We fished right from the ramp and followed the shore all the way to the Halfway Bay headland then turned around and fished all the way back again. It was an enjoyable day and we caught fish at intervals right throughout the trip back to Kingston. We were surprised to hear that most of the boats found the fishing difficult .

This trip I took more notice of the performance of the boat. I normally troll at about 2.5 to 3 miles per hour and this time into the wind and the waves that required to motor to run at 1000 to 1200rpm on the tacho. On the return home with the waves and wind to the stern we were pushed along at 3.5mph and with the motor at its slowest speed of 700rpm for steerage, we couldn't go any slower and we still caught fish. We are not expert fishermen and have often returned home fishless but I think our seven fish on the day are due to having a line in the water for the whole time we were on the water. On the day, black and gold Toby and pink Tilans were the answer. With single hooks we never missed a fish. The weigh-in and BBQ started at 5.30 and was an excellent affair. Highlight was young Lochie Mcdowall with the second biggest fish, caught at the 11th hour off the east end of the Kingston beach, his first fish. I tried to buy it off him before the weigh-in but he wasn't having a bar of it. Thanks to the Smiths and the Chittocks for organising an excellent event and to the boat club members who took part.

Recipes



Creamy Spinach & Salmon Pasta

Ingredients:

1½ cups chopped spinach or baby spinach leaves
1 x 400g packet fresh fettuccine
2 tbsp. butter
3 large cloves garlic, chopped
1 tbsp. plain flour
½ cup white wine
1 cup cream
Zest of 1 lemon
500g salmon fillet, skinned and boned, chopped into bite sized pieces
½ cup freshly grated parmesan
Salt and freshly cracked black pepper
1 tbsp. chopped fresh dill
5–6 fresh basil leaves, chopped roughly
Chopped fresh parsley leaves to garnish
Extra parmesan to garnish
Lemon cheeks or wedges to serve

Method:

Blanch the spinach in boiling water, then refresh in cold water. Squeeze out the excess moisture and set aside.

Bring a saucepan of salted water to the boil and cook the pasta according to the packet instructions. Drain and set aside until needed. Melt the butter in a frying pan over a medium heat and sauté the garlic for 3–4 minutes. Add the flour and cook for another 4–5 minutes.

Add the wine slowly, whisking while you add it to avoid lumps forming.

Add the cream, lemon zest, salmon, blanched spinach and parmesan.

Simmer for 5 minutes until the sauce has thickened and the salmon is cooked through. Taste and season with salt and pepper.

Stir through the dill and basil. Toss through the cooked pasta and garnish with parsley, extra parmesan and lemon cheeks.


