

Recipes



Beef, Mint & Feta Open Pies

Ingredients:

500g Quality Mark beef mince
100g feta, crumbled
1 tablespoon ground cumin
½ cup chopped fresh mint leaves
3 sheets ready rolled puff pastry
1 egg, beaten
40g pine nuts

Method:

Preheat fan forced oven to 200°C.
Line oven tray with baking paper.
Combine mince, feta, cumin and mint.
Divide into 12 portions.
Cut pastry sheets into 4 squares.
Brush edges with beaten egg. Place portion of beef mix in centre of pastry. Fold each corner of the pastry in toward the centre, pressing down gently and leaving filling visible.
Brush lightly with egg and sprinkle with pine nuts.
Place pies glazed side up on baking tray.
Cook for 15 - 20 minutes or until golden brown and pastry is crisp.

Serve with rocket salad and dollop of natural yoghurt

USA and CANADA HOLIDAY

Miriam & I have not long returned from a holiday and I hope Shoreline readers will find our travels of interest. Our reason for heading to the States was to attend the biggest Jewellery exhibition and show in Las Vegas. The show was held in the huge Mandalay Bay convention centre and we felt privileged to be able to see such a fantastic array of beautiful jewellery and gems and even purchased some product that will be in store soon. The weather was a bit of a shock as we left with snow in the air in NZ to 45 degrees in the desert city. Next stop was the beautiful city of Washington with all the best that the capital city has to offer. The city is green and clean, with comfortable temperatures made exploring the famous monuments and displays throughout the city such as the Abraham Lincoln, Washington, Martin Luther King, Franklin D Roosevelt, Iwo Jima, Vietnam and more, very interesting and at times quite moving. The city has many museums and galleries that we managed to see some of, such as the art gallery and the Air Sea and Space display, I enjoyed the international spy museum as well as the Capitol building and Georgetown all making for an enjoyable few days before the next busy part of our trip, New York.

We travelled a comfortable 3 hours by train from Union Station to Penn Station in New York and arrived in a mad house! Wow. Nothing compares to the noise, colour and bustle of the big apple with everything happening at once, sirens, horns, alarms they have it all.

But really exciting and a buzz that is hard to describe. It did look calmer from our hotel room on the 30th floor looking down on Grand Central Station. I was surprised at how safe it felt walking about on the street and I didn't see any dispute or problems although there are lots of homeless people about. We walked pretty much everywhere as we felt it was faster than taxis or hop on hop off bus which seemed to crawl from one traffic jam to another and again enjoyed many of the highlights such as the top of the Empire State, 9/11 memorial, Statue of Liberty, and a couple of Broadway shows in the evening. Miriam was keen to go to a gospel church, so we ventured out to Harlem and experienced a church service with the preacher in fine voice and great singing. Fun being in Fifth Avenue and Times Square with people shoulder to shoulder and seeing where the clock ticks down to the New Year we see on TV every year.

Next stop was the tranquillity of Niagara Falls where we stayed on the Canadian side and had the good fortune to have the hotel directly above the massive falls so we could look from our room onto them. Another Wow! time as they are amazing, so powerful and awe inspiring, the volume of water pouring over the edge is amazing and the noise and mist all add to the grandeur of it all, especially from the boat below the falls looking up at them. Niagara Falls is a nice town and while there we ventured down to a beautiful little place called Niagara on the Lake about 20 minutes away where everything is so perfect, not a blade of grass out of place... it's a bit similar to Arrowtown with its lovely character buildings.

Leaving Canada, back to America and then we flew to Calgary in Canada again where we welcomed by Miriam's extended family who live close by for a few days. From there we hired a car and drove through the Rocky Mountains to Vancouver via Canmore, Banff, Jasper, Kamloops and Whistler. I highly recommend this trip as it not only easy driving but the scenery is simply spectacular with massive mountains and where we have bush they have trees so similar to our place but much bigger.

WAIHOLA MARATHON



SAMOA 2016

In mid-June we once again made our way to SAMOA to the warm air and sea. It was just as good as last time [2 years ago] with just a little rain while we were in the Capital City of Apia. We go to a Marine Reserve right on the edge of town and snorkel where there is a very good number of fish. We also found a new place on the South side of the main Island that has another Marine Reserve and Conservation area where they are making an effort to breed and protect Giant Clams. After nearly all their Clams were eaten or destroyed by cyclones they are trying to grow them back. They have imported a large number of Clams from Tonga and Palau and set them in a secluded bay guarded by the local Villagers marked of with buoys. For a small fee we were allowed to snorkel out 100m or so to swim with them. What a truly beautiful sight they were with so many different vibrant colours. We spent over an hour swimming around them as some were up to one meter long and some babies as well. While there we saw three wild Turtles that came along for a look. I've tried to keep up with them before so I did not try to do so this time, good to see though it was a nice bonus deal.

After a few days we travelled to the second Island of Samoa to a place where we stay in a hut with platted Coconut tree leaves for walls and just a mattress for furniture. This is a bit like a camping, they feed us breakfast and dinner. There is also a bunch of Bananas hanging on the diner wall which you can partake of for free, very tasty. The sea here is very easy to swim in and very warm so we do a lot of snorkelling. We then moved further south to almost the end of the Island (SAVAII) where we went to a place we had seen on a previous trip and thought it looked good and it certainly was. It was probably as good a setting that we have found in Samoa for what we like to do. We had a nice little cabin just across a small track then a buffer wall and then onto the beach to the water. There was a nice part that was sheltered, no current, it was calm and had a good selection of Corals including some large tall pillars and lots of small colourful fish. It was so very good one day with such calm conditions that when we got back from a snorkel we were very surprised to find that we had spent two and a half hours swimming.

Once again a great relaxing time.


