Racing at Benmore & Aviemore

There are plenty of boats that like to stay warm and dry in their sheds for winter.

But not all boats feel this way, some like to race in the New Zealand Boat Marathon Commission series.

There are 8 days of racing from April to August.

On the 17th and 18th of June was the Benmore and Aviemore races.

It was cold and calm as the race started but 23 boats cut up Sailors Cutting then headed through the gorge and straight up to the finish line at the outlet of Ohau C. Coming out of the gorge there was fog that got thicker up the lake. **I was glad I wasn't first because I was following the boat ahead so I didn't get lost. The return leg was to be the same but the fog was not safe** with the A class boats capable of over 150 km. So we came through the fog before starting the race back through the gorge to the finish.

The next day was Aviemore and it was even colder. Last year a boat went out for an early morning test then back on the trailer.

When it was time to race the boat would not come off the trailer. It had frozen onto the trailer and had to be rocked hard to free it.

It was a good race track with some parts glass calm and other parts rough with big white caps.

This race was 9 laps for A and B class. 7 laps for C and D. 5 laps for E and F.

Classes are on how much horse power your boat has. No limit for A class down to under 90 hp for F class.

Speeds ranged from 125 km from a North Island cat down to 50 km from an Invercargill fishing boat.

The prize giving are low key with a goal of having fun not winning prizes.

It would be great to see more family boats competing. You don't have to thrash your boats in the speed races just cruise and try to win the nominated speed. That is picking a speed and sticking to it. It's not as easy as it sounds with other boat wakes and corners and changing water conditions.

What better way is there to spend the weekend? Buzzing around in your boat then having a beer and a laugh with mates.


